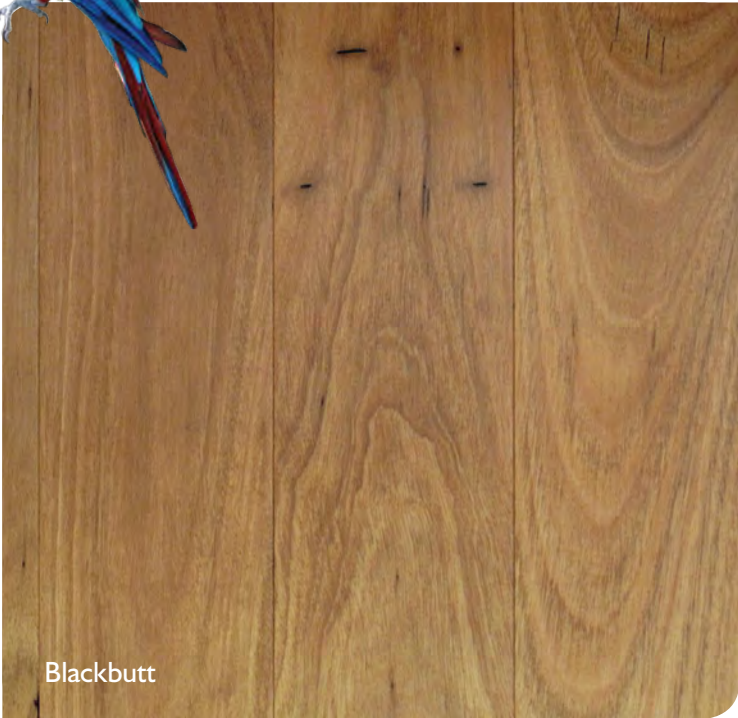
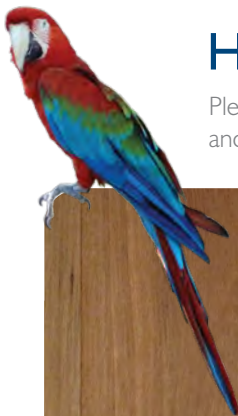

Care & Maintenance

Caring for your Hardwood Plus floor is easy. Vacuum or sweep the floor to remove dirt and debris, and use a slightly damp (but not wet) mop for regular cleaning. For preventative care, entrance mats and rugs in high wear areas should be considered together with felt protectors for furniture and appliances.

Our range of signature timbers combine the rugged strength and durability for which Australian wood species are renowned, carefully engineered to produce sustainable flooring with long lasting appeal.

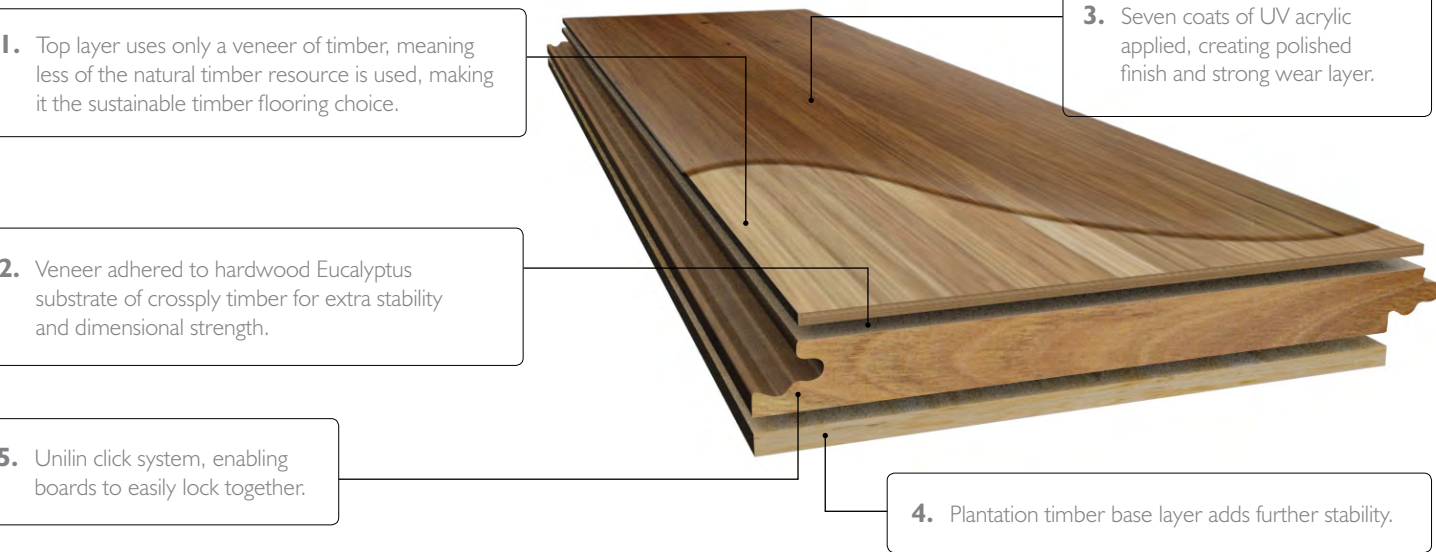
With colours ranging from the brilliant dark red of Jarrah to the lighter blond shades of Tasmanian Oak, Hardwood Plus offers a timber floor to match the most demanding interior design preferences.

Quality Assured Manufacture

The carefully controlled manufacturing process produces a multilayer, precision-engineered flooring system designed for Australian living at its best.

Beginning with the selection of sustainability certified timber for the top appearance layer, the manufacturing process gives particular emphasis to moisture control and surface preparation.

Moisture content

Unwanted moisture can be timber's worst enemy so effective control of moisture content is an essential part of the production process. All components of the floor are kiln dried and monitored at each stage of manufacture to ensure optimum moisture balance in the finished product.

Seven layer coating for wear resistance

After a final moisture check the raw engineered board is finished with a seven coat system under strictly controlled conditions. All layers of the UV cured coating system, including the scratch resistant top coat, are formulated to react with each other so that the finished board is ready for immediate use. No further surface treatment is required.



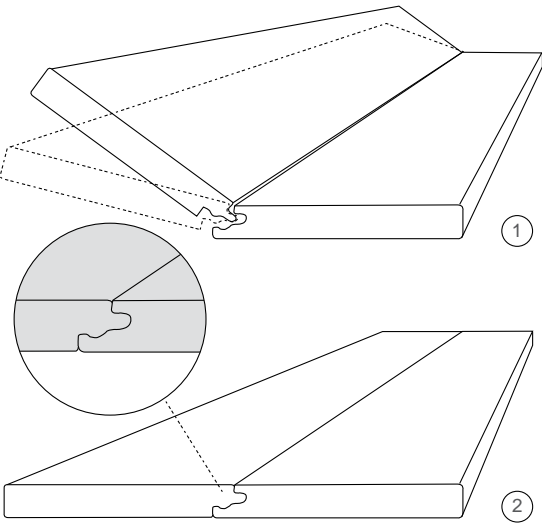

Click-together assembly for easy installation

Using the Unilin click system, the world's most recognized locking assembly method, Hardwood Plus boards simply click together. Quicker to install than traditional tongue and groove flooring, no glue is necessary and the tightly locked joints ensure easy assembly for both the DIY or professional floor layer.



Install and walk on in the same day

Although designed as a floating floor system, Hardwood Plus can be stuck directly to concrete, plywood or particle board subfloors.

When floating, Hardwood Plus should be laid over Embelton's Softwalk 2mm combination foam underlay, which also acts to prevent moisture coming up through the floor.

For acoustically rated installations, Embelton ImpactaMat or Silent Night underlays offer effective reduction of both reflected and transmitted noise.

If directly adhered to a concrete slab, a properly applied waterproofing barrier is needed to prevent absorption of moisture by the timber.

Selection of the finest timbers, sourced from FSC-certified forests, ensures that Hardwood Plus is an ethical choice.

Well maintained engineered flooring can last for years but, like solid timber, a Hardwood Plus engineered floor can be re-sanded and polished to restore its natural beauty as it ages.
